3. School Report - Jacqui Holmes

- Registration for the 2019/2020 school year begins February 1st and closes February 28th. You can register easily on Powerschool. Registration is necessary even for returning students and will replace the correction letters that are usually sent out. Students can also seek boundary exemptions during this time.
- The Grade7 accountability survey as well as the Cloverbar general school survey will be sent out soon. It is important that these surveys are completed as the information is used to make changes to the school.
- Mid-term exams are January 30, 31st and February 1st. Students are encouraged to seek help if they need it. There is peer tutoring in the library and the library is open during the lunch hour for students wanting to study. Term 2 starts January 31st so there is some overlap.
