

FAQ'S for Exams

Finals are quickly approaching, and expectations about what is to happen before, during and after each exam are not always clear for parents and students. The following are answers to Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs) that Clover Bar junior high teachers field from year to year.

What are the days and times of the Finals?

Each final is scheduled for only **Blocks 1, 2 and 3 only** (8:48am – 11:30am) on each of the following days:

- Wednesday, June 19th – Math Exam Part A
- Monday, June 24th – Social Exam Part B
- Tuesday, June 25th- ELA Exam Part B
- Wednesday, June 26th- Math Exam Part B
- Thursday, June 27th- Science Final

Are students able to leave when they have completed their exam?

In order to ensure a structured learning environment for each student, no one will be dismissed prior to 11:30 AM. Each student is asked to bring a study materials or a book to utilized should they finish early.

Are there classes after each exam?

Classes will continue in the afternoon after each exam. Students will be able to attend review sessions with a teacher during regularly scheduled classes.

Is my child able to study at home?

Yes, students are able to study at home providing parents advise the school in writing. Please submit these notifications via email or a handwritten note.

How can I support my child's success?

Learners of all ages need to prepare ahead of time for assessments; cramming the night before is not effective. Please help your child set aside some time each day to review in each of their four core subject areas. Studying with the proper tools (for example – using a calculator, not a cell phone, for Math calculations) helps build student confidence. A good night's rest, a healthy breakfast, and arriving on time – these all reduce student stress and anxiety, which in turn allow students to do a better job of showing what they know during assessments.
